

Why SinuSpray ?

- Sinus disease is often a localized mucosal disease. While systemic antibiotics are usually needed, disease may often be managed with topical preparations. For patients with subacute or chronic disease, this is most important especially after systemic therapy.
- Even with excellent surgery, some patients continue to have mucosal "weeping" of mucopurulent secretions that may easily be managed with topical treatments.
- Many patients who have localized disease also have mucociliary dysfunction and there is stasis of secretions. These patients may need irrigation to wash away stagnant debris, bacteria, and secretions.
- SinuSprays have an acceptable cost. The average price of \$100 for a thirty day supply compares favorably to a typical 10 day course of oral antibiotics that may cost the same or even more (\$75 -125).
- SinuSprays can be custom compounded based on culture, sensitivity, and patient history of reaction.
- SinuSprays can eliminate the edema at the surgical site in post-operative patients.
- SinuSprays can decrease the fungal population at the sinus site and improve the function of the sinuses.
- SinuSprays can be used as a topical antibiotic adjunctive therapy to IV Antibiotics.
- SinuSprays can be more effective in eliminating fungal infections and can replace oral fungal agents which often times patients may not tolerate.
- SinuSprays can decrease the mucous membrane edema and decrease the systemic absorption, which occurs with oral use.
- SinuSprays are prepared under aseptic conditions in a class 100 clean room.
- SinuSprays are prepared without preservatives and have been independently tested to assure potency and stability.
